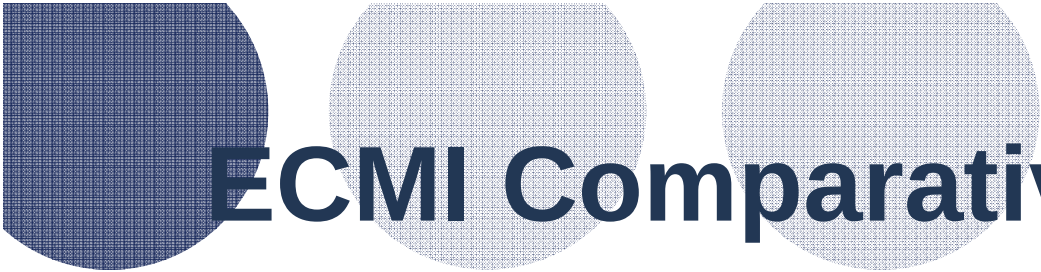
ECMI Mission

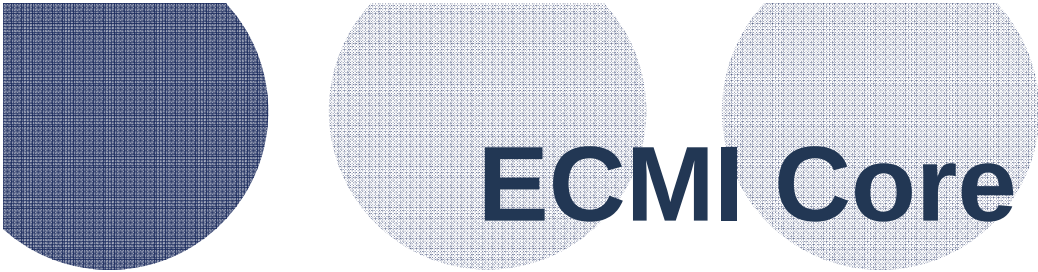

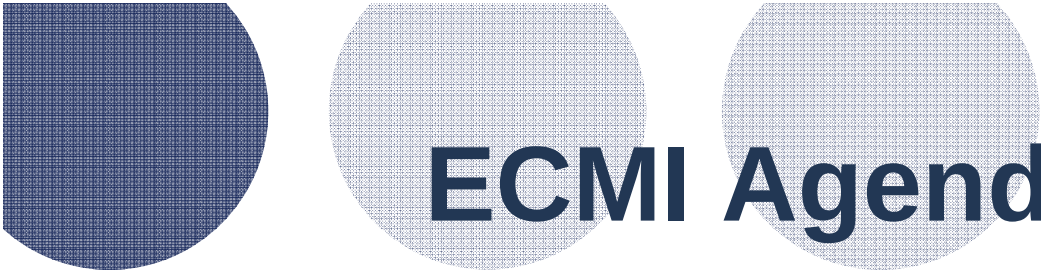
ECMI Comparative Advantage
